INTENT

The County of Mercer request bids for Mobile Radiology Services at the Mercer County Correction Center, located at 1750 River Road, Hopewell Township, New Jersey for a period of two (2) years. Bidders shall provide a cost per study on the proposal page. The County will pay for those services rendered. The County requests all-inclusive costs for studies and results. The awarded vendor shall provide detailed reporting on a monthly basis. Bidders shall provide a unit cost for echocardiograms and vascular ultrasounds which shall cover the cost for study and evaluation. Respondents shall provide three references for similar work performed over the last three years. Contact will commence September 2023. LICENSURE

Services must be performed by Radiographic Technicians licensed through the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Radiological Health as required through N.J.S.A. 26:2D-24 and N.J.A.C. 7:28-19. Bidders shall submit proof of licensure with bid submission.

SCOPE OF WORK

RADIOLOGY SERVICES

Contractor shall provide equipment, technicians, and services as required at the Mercer County Correction Center. All technicians are to be duly licensed where required by applicable law, and are to be and remain employees of the Contractor. All such technicians will be duly qualified in their respective fields by training and experience, and each shall be supervised in the performance of his/her activities by duly qualified and licensed supervisory personnel of the Contractor.

All radiographic procedures performed are to be read and interpreted by a qualified licensed consulting physician selected by the Radiology Contractor.

Technician shall provide service on two (2) mutually agreeable days during the workweek by the Contractor to the Mercer County Correctional Center for on-site radiology services. Services are to be rendered in accordance with physician's orders. Required X-RAY technicians will be on call between the hours of 7:30 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. in the event a stat film is needed.

Radiology Contractor shall also participate in "In Service" training programs of the Correctional Center if such participation is requested by the County. Such participation shall be no additional cost to the County.

Copies of all results of procedures rendered are to be provided to the County in accordance with the instructions of the ordering physician.

Radiology Contractor is to transmit oral and written reports to the Correctional Facilities for all x-rays.

Radiology Contractor shall perform all billing. Billing shall be patient specific. The Correctional Facility will assist the Radiology Company in acquiring the necessary information required for accurate billing.

Radiology Contractor shall provide these services at a rate per procedure, with procedure defined as each anatomical body part requiring an x-ray. Example: right knee, right ankle and right foot x-ray on the same person would comprise three procedures. Chest and abdomen would comprise two procedures. Billed fees are to include interpretation fee of the radiologist. Any ultrasound Echo/Vascular Study will be considered as a separate procedure. Statistics are broken down on the proposal page.

TELERADIOLOGY

Teleradiology shall be provided for inmates i.e., image from the mobile equipment would be interpreted immediately offsite for the purposes of interpretation or consultation.

Teleradiology improves patient care by allowing Radiologists to provide services without actually having to be at the location of the patient. This is important when a sub specialist such as a MRI Radiologist, Neuroradiologist or Musculoskeletal Radiologist is needed as these professionals are generally only located in large metropolitan areas working during day time hours. Teleradiology allows for trained specialists to be available 24/7.

Teleradiology network is performed using standard network technologies such as the <u>internet</u>, <u>telephone</u> lines, <u>wide area network</u> (WAN), or over a <u>local area network</u> (LAN). Highly specialized software is used to transmit the images and enable the Radiologist to effectively analyze what can be 100's of images for a given study. Technologies such as advanced graphics processing, voice recognition, and image compression are often used in Teleradiology. Through Teleradiology, images can be sent to another part of the hospital, or to other locations around the world.
