INTENT

The County of Mercer requests bids for on behalf of the County and The Mercer County Cooperative Contract Purchasing System, with The County of Mercer acting as the Lead Agency to purchase Fuel Oil No. 2. The contract shall be awarded for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend one (1) year. The quantities referenced are estimated. All oil deliveries should be automatic unless specifically recommended. The awarded Contractor shall invoice the County based upon the OPIS Production, Oil Price Daily, adding the delivery charge. The County anticipates ordering approximately 257,891 gallons of Fuel Oil No. 2 annually; however, this is an estimate and quantities may increase or decrease. Please email all questions to imaldonado@mercercounty.org or via the BidNet portal. Contract shall commence July 2024.

GENERAL

Fuel supplied under this contract shall comply with the requirements of ASTM D396-10, "Standard Specification for Fuel Oils," and any amendments thereto, New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection "Air Pollution Control (Sulfur in Fuel), NJAC Title 7, Chapter 27. All fuel supplied must conform in every respect to all standards and regulations established by Federal and New Jersey State laws. If any of the applicable standards and regulations are updated/revised during the term of the contract; the contractor must conform to the latest version.

SULFUR CONTENT OF HEATING OIL

Heating oil is a type of distillate fuel. Respondents shall comply with N.J.A.C. 7:27-9.2. With regard to No. 2, all fuel oil stored, offered for sale, sold, delivered, exchanged in trade for use, or used in New Jersey must contain no more than 500 parts per million (500 ppm). This was effective July 1, 2014. On or before July 1, 2016, all such No. 2 oil must contain no more than 15 ppm sulfur content.

OIL PRICE DAILY, AN OPIS PUBLICATION

Bidders shall utilize The Oil Price Daily, OPIS Publication, Newark pricing, Column entitled "No. 2 Oil"., the OPIS, Newark pricing will reflect product with 15 ppm.

GRADE 2 INTENDED USE AND FUNCTIONS

The fuel oil described in the specification is to be used in fuel oil burning equipment, which converts chemical energy to heat energy for the purpose of providing heat in Mercer County institutions and buildings.

DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS

Delivery shall be F.O.B. destination to the County's storage tanks. Fuel Oil shall be delivered in metered trucks in accordance with New Jersey State Law, N.J.S.A. 519-5

covering liquid fuel with A.P.I. gravity greater than 22. This includes grades 2 and 4. These grades shall not be temperature compensated. All deliveries are to be made within **twenty-four (24) hours** after receipt of purchase order or authorized verbal requests. All deliveries are to be made between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm on business weekdays except as otherwise arranged by supplier and purchaser. Placement of orders and delivery arrangement shall be made by each participating unit directly with the supplier.

QUANTITIES

The quantities listed in the proposal are estimated quantities only, based on past usage and consumption. The contract shall be for the actual quantities ordered and received during the contract.

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

All grades of oil supplied to this specification are to be low sulfur oils (0.02%). Oils shall comply with the NJ Air Pollution Control Code Chapter X, "Sulfur in Fuels", and the NJ Administrative Code Title 7, Chapter 27, Subchapter 9.2 as amended (N.J.A.C. 7:27-9.2).

All grades of low sulfur fuel oil are to be homogeneous hydrocarbon oils free from organic acid.

All grades of low sulfur fuel oils are to be free of excessive amounts of solid or fibrous foreign matter likely to foul or damage filter screens. The grades of oil containing residual components are to remain uniform during normal storage and are not to separate by gravity into light and heavy oil components outside the viscosity limits for the grade. The grades of oil supplied to this specification are to meet the physical and chemical requirements.

TESTING

Fuel oils shall be sampled and tested against the requirements of Table 1. If independent testing is required, the vendor will bear the expense.

INFORMATION

Bidders are cautioned to fill in all information as requested on the proposal form to serve as a basis for making awards. All prices must be clearly stated on lines provided. If not quoting on all items listed, bidder shall indicate "No Bid" on appropriate lines. By submitting a proposal the prospective Vendor covenants and agrees that they fully understand their obligation and that they will not make claim for or have right to cancellation or relief without penalty of the contract because of any misunderstanding or lack of information.

PRICES

Prices shall be net unit price exclusive of all taxes and must include all transportation and delivery cost F.O.B. Destination. The inability of any vendor to bid on all items will not preclude consideration of his bid; however, it is understood that the County will consider the cost of handling as well as the service factor involved in splitting the contract. **Bidders shall bid based upon average of the high and low Newark, NJ pricing in the Production,**

Oil Price Daily, Formerly the Journal of Commerce on May 20,2024. Attach a copy of the May 20,2024 pricing Page to your bid response.

INVOICING

Bidder will provide invoicing breakdown of fluctuating and fixed cost. Bidders shall invoice based upon average of the high and low Newark, NJ pricing in the OPIS Production, Oil Price Daily, Formerly the Journal of Commerce.

INVOICE COST OF FUEL OIL NO. 2

The contractor shall charge the County for each delivery as follows:

- 1. An OPIS Production, Oil Price Daily, based on the daily average of the high and low Newark Prices. E.g., if the pricing fluctuates between \$1.4225 and \$1.5320 the County will pay \$1.4725 per gallon.
- 2. Add fixed delivery and other charges as entered on price page, in bid.
- 3. Enter net price per gallon.
- 4. Multiply by number of gallons for invoice total.

DEVIATIONS

All deviations from the specifications must be noted in detail by the Vendor in writing at the time of submittal of the formal bid. The absence of said deviations at the time of submittal of the bid will hold the Vendor strictly accountable to the County for furnishing the requirements in full accordance with the specifications.

PAYMENT

Purchase orders will be generated for each delivery covering the quantity to be charged to each Department. Payments will be made to the successful vendor in accordance with the contract documents upon receipt of invoice and a properly executed Purchase Order. Vendor shall provide invoicing detailing the cost of the commodity per the An OPIS Production, Oil Price Daily, Formerly the Journal of Commerce daily rate (average of the high and low, Newark pricing) and the fixed delivery charge.

Payment to vendor will be made only for the actual quantities furnished in accordance with the contract and it is understood that the estimated quantities to be furnished may be increased or diminished without in any way invalidating prices bid.
