SPECIFICATIONS ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER HEAVY DUTY VEHICLES OVER 14,500 GVW FOR SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENT PARTS FOR THE COUNTY OF MERCER MOTOR POOL DIVISION

INTENT

The purpose of this solicitation is to obtain services for Original Equipment Manufacturer Heavy Duty Vehicle for specialized equipment repair and replacement parts for the County of Mercer Motor Pool Division. The contract will be for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend one (1) year. The awarded vendor(s) must be a licensed auto repair dealers per NJ. Admin Code S39:13-2. This bid will be awarded to multiple vendors whom are deemed responsive and responsible per bid specification. The award will be based on the lowest unit cost for parts & repair at a flat hourly rate and the highest percentage discount for O.E.M. over counter parts. The hourly rate is all inclusive no additional charges are permitted for shipping, diagnostics, repairmen etc.

WARRANTY

- All original equipment manufacturer hereinafter referred to as O.E.M. parts supplied for this contract shall carry the standard Manufacturer's warranty and/or a warranty for a period of one (1) year. The county will implement both warranties for whichever warranty is greater.
- All parts furnished must be new or OEM remanufactured and, in the manufacturer's, original standard package. Parts provided shall be guaranteed against faulty material and workmanship in accordance with the manufacturer's standard warranty. Any faulty part must be replaced by the contractor at no cost within one week (7 days) of notice.

Equipment Repair Requirements

_

- No repair will be performed without prior approval from Mercer County.
 This directive will come from the Motor Pool Supervisor
- No bill will be rendered for any repair that has not been performed.
 Invoice must be available upon completion of repair at time of pickup.
- All repairs and service shall be completed within 48-72 hours upon delivery
 of the equipment. Any extension of this time must have prior approval
 from Mercer County. Every effort must be made to meet appointment
 schedules and promised completion times.
- A written estimate shall be provided before any repairs or service can take place, based off the contracted rates. All estimates must be provided to Motor Pool Supervisor within 24 hours.
- Vendor must be able to perform OEM factory warranty repairs and recalls.
- All equipment and vehicles must be protected while in the possession of the vendor. The County will assume responsibility once vehicle is delivered per FOB Destination.
- Unless otherwise instructed by Mercer County Motor Pool Supervisor, all parts that are removed in the repair of the vehicle must be returned with the vehicle or equipment.
- Once repairs are completed, the vehicles shall be subjected to inspection by Mercer County. The County will inspect vehicle within (3) three days of receipt of repaired vehicles. The (3) three-day period does not include holidays or emergency closings of all County facilities. If the repair services are not properly performed, the vehicle will be returned to the contractor for corrective repairs. All corrective repairs will be performed at no additional charge to Mercer County.
- Any additional repair service and/or parts that the contractor deems necessary, beyond the original estimate, must first be approved by Mercer County Motor Pool Supervisor via written evaluation.
- All warranty claims will be completed within 24-48 hours at no additional cost to Mercer County. Meaning if part is returned for defect the vendor must make good on the warranty within 24-48 hours.
- Compliance with all Federal, State or local Department of Environmental hereinafter referred to as D.E.P. standards and regulations will be the responsibility of each contractor. The awarded vendor must be a licensed auto repair dealers per NJ. Admin Code \$39:13-2. No additional charges will be accepted for the proper disposal of any used fluids such as motor oil or antifreeze.

Replacement Parts

- Replacement parts shall be for Heavy Duty Vehicles with 14,500 GVW or higher.
- Pricing for OEM replacement parts shall be based on a percentage discount from the current list price. The Manufacturer List Price for replacement parts MUST be provide with bid submission. FAILURE TO PROVIDE THIS PRICE LIST WILL BE CAUSE FOR REJECTION. Upon award vendor (s) will provide a copy of the price list via USB drive and website.
- All replacements parts must reference and list OEM part number on estimate and invoice.

REBUILT OR REMANUFACTURED PARTS

 Rebuilt or remanufactured parts can be bid. If the awarded vendor is providing rebuilt or remanufactured parts the vendor must advise the Motor Pool Supervisor. Invoices for rebuilt or remanufactured parts must be identified on the invoice (RB) next to part number.

OEM PARTS

Pricing for parts OEM or rebuilt/remanufactured parts will be based on a percentage discount from the list price. The list price will stay constant throughout the contract period. The percentage discount will be taken from the OEM parts price list catalog, USB, CD or DVD, AND Web-Site on the vehicles and equipment bid. Rebuilt or remanufactured parts may be used, subject to prior approval by Mercer County or its owners. **Must include OEM parts price list along with bid response.**

REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

Compliance with all Federal, State or local D.E.P. standards or regulations will be the responsibility of each contractor. No additional charges will be accepted for the proper disposal of any used fluids such as motor oil or antifreeze.

MAINTENANCE FACILITY / GARAGE

The winning contractor must have access to a minimum Two (2) bay areas in a garage facility and / or servicing area. The garage area may be subject to inspection by Mercer County representative. If the vendor has more than one location, all locations must be listed and included with the bid package. The maintenance facility must have all of the equipment and tools to provide repairs and parts for the vehicles listed in this bid specification. The vehicles shall include the following but not limited to:

- 1. TRUCKS 14,500 GVW EQUAL OR GREATER
- 2. VANS 14,500 GVW EQUAL OR GREATER
- 3. BUSES 14,500 GVW EQUAL OR GREATER
- 4. ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN 14,500 GVW
