WHEREAS, Elcon Recycling's Haifa Bay plant in Israel, due to its history of violations of air and groundwater emissions and its negative impact, and pollution to the surrounding environment in Haifa Bay, has been ordered to shut down and relocate to a remote desert location in Israel; and,

WHEREAS, given the extremely close proximity to the Delaware River and high residential population and due to high possibility of spillage, pollution would affect the Delaware River to the Chesapeake Bay and beyond; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware River is a primary source of drinking water and recreation; and,

WHEREAS, there are reports, students, and history that indicate this type of treatment plant will in fact, pollute the surrounding area and waterways and be detrimental to the environment of residents and wildlife; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders does hereby oppose the construction of the Elcon Toxic Waste Incinerator in Falls Township, Pennsylvania; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk to the Board shall forward one certified copy of this Resolution to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, Falls Township Board of Supervisors, the Legislators representing Mercer County and the Clerk of the Boards of Chosen Freeholders throughout the State of New Jersey.
