ORDINANCE NO. 2016-5

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey does hereby Ordain as follows:

1. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish a Midblock Crosswalk where pedestrians may legally cross the roadway; said location being between two intersecting roadways fully described and as set forth below.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, which does confer Mercer County the right to establish certain regulations in the interest of safety and the expedition of traffic on roadways under Mercer County jurisdiction.
3. The location herein is designated as a Midblock Crosswalk.

Location

Beginning at a point approximately 525 feet east of Orchard Avenue and extending 10 feet easterly therefrom. Said location to coincide with the easterly side of John Plant Drive, a non-public access.

4. Regulatory and Warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated Midblock Crosswalk in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board shall forward two (2) executed copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer, one (1) executed copy to the office of the Borough of Hightstown Clerk, and a copy to the Office of the Deputy Administrator/Director, Department Transportation and Infrastructure.
