Recognizing Joseph Schmeltz of the Mercer County Wildlife Center

Whereas, the Mercer County Wildlife Center is a state and federally licensed facility that provides critical treatment and rehabilitation services for injured, ill, and displaced wildlife to enable these animals to return to the wild; and

Whereas, the Mercer County Wildlife Center marks its 35th Anniversary with a celebration at the Mercer County Wildlife Center's Outdoor Education Pavilion on Thursday, October 4, 2018; and

Whereas, the Mercer County Wildlife Center was founded by Joseph Schmeltz in the basement of the Mercer County Correction Center in 1983 to help wildlife in distress after Washington Crossing State Park stopped accepting animals; and

Whereas, Joseph Schmeltz had the vision to establish the Mercer County Wildlife Center while meeting another need of a newly created work program for inmates of the Mercer County Correction Center, who became vital to the operation; and

Whereas, Joseph Schmeltz oversaw the early growth of the Mercer County Wildlife Center, laying the foundation for the unique, modern facility it has become,
