

MERCER COUNTY BOARD OF TAXATION

MINUTES

May 2, 2016

The meeting of the Mercer County Board of Taxation was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Commissioner Richard Carabelli and in attendance were Commissioners Edward Hoffman, Rose Marie Bowen-Lewis, Gino Melone, Victoria Plumeri and Tax Administrator Martin Guhl.

After a statement that the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act had been met, President Carabelli was unanimously re-elected as President for 2016.

The Board then adopted meeting dates for the 2016 year.

Resolution #16-2 setting 100% as the ratio of assessment for 2016 and Resolution 16-1 appointing Administrator Guhl as custodian of the tax board's public records was approved.

Administrator Guhl presented the preliminary equalization table to the board, to which the board unanimously adopted as final.

Appeals filed after the appeal deadline were dismissed for late filing.

A motion to dismiss for failure to file chapter 91 for Princeton was approved. Non-payment of tax motions for Trenton City were also approved.

Tax appeals were heard for the following:

Lawrence Township
Robbinsville Township
West Windsor Township

All judgments were rendered.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
