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

Murphy issued Executive Order No. 103, wherein he declared both a Public Health Emergency and a State of Emergency throughout the State due to the public health hazard created by Coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19"); and,

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 103 remains in full force and effect as of the date of this Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has greatly affected students' ability to attend MCCC classes and remain enrolled as full-time students, thereby potentially jeopardizing the students' ability to be eligible for and to receive the full amount available through the Scholarship; and,

WHEREAS, in recognition of the extraordinary and unprecedented circumstances resulting from the public health crisis, the Board of Commissioners believes it to be in the best interests of the MCCC students to waive the "full-time basis" requirement; and,

WHEREAS, this waiver shall only apply to recipients that are currently receiving the scholarship as of the date of this Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, this waiver shall be contingent upon Executive Order No. 103 remaining in effect. Once this Executive Order is rescinded, this waiver shall expire; and,

WHEREAS, this waiver shall not automatically renew should a different Executive Order, whether it be for COVID-19 or another public health emergency, be issued by the Governor. The Board will have to adopt a separate resolution to grant a temporary waiver to the Scholarship requirements; and,
