

Today, voting is easier than ever. All registered voters in New Jersey can vote by mail. It allows you to vote without going to the polls on Election Day. **No more waiting. No more long lines. No more worrying about work schedules, illnesses, or not being in the area on Election Day.** In fact, voters can cast their votes up to 45 days before an election.

You can vote with a mail-in ballot for any reason in New Jersey! Mail-in ballots are now good for a variety of durations. If you choose, you may get a mail-in ballot

- For a single election, or
- For all future elections until otherwise requested

The Mercer County Clerk's Office now offers postage-free ballot mailing, so in some cases you never have to leave your home to vote.

Numerous options are available to obtain a mail-in ballot:

- **Call 609-989-6494 and ask** to have a mail-in ballot application mailed to your address
- **Go online** and download the application from <https://www.state.nj.us/state/elections/vote-by-mail.shtml> and mail to the County Clerk (address below). It's available in multiple languages. Affix proper postage.
- **Apply in person** at the Mercer County Clerk's Office. If you apply in person 45 days or less prior to an election, you can obtain your ballot while you wait. Our office offers some evening and weekend extended hours prior to Election Day. Once you obtain an application, simply complete it and sign where indicated. Return it to the County Clerk, who will issue you a ballot. After you have voted on your ballot, return it either in person, by

mail to the County Board of Elections, or one of the secure **drop boxes** throughout Mercer County.
