


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A MERCER COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, PURSUANT TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE PLAN OF THE OPTIONAL COUNTY CHARTER LAW (N.J.S.A.40:41A-1 ET. SEQ.) – ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PERMITTING, AND THE IMPOSITION OF CERTAIN FEES, FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES AT THE TRENTON-MERCER AIRPORT; RENTAL CAR COMPANIES (AMENDMENT NO. 17)

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WHEREAS, on or about April 24, 2003, the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted Ordinance No. 2003-8, which restated, amended and adopted in its entirety the Mercer County, New Jersey Administrative Code ("Code"); and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.01.02 of the Code, the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders has the power to adopt ordinances to amend the Code as it deems appropriate and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Mercer owns and operates the Trenton-Mercer Airport, located in the Township of Ewing, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey; and,

WHEREAS, the County desires to establish certain uniform permitting and fees for the use of facilities at the Trenton-Mercer Airport with respect to car rental companies; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders, that the Mercer County Administrative Code shall be amended to provide as follows:

1. Title 6, Airport.

Section 6.02.060. Rental car companies; permit fee.

- a. Companies seeking to provide car rental services on Airport property shall be required to complete and submit an application to the County for a rental car operator ground transportation permit, on such forms as prepared and approved by the County. The application fee of \$50.00 shall be required for each application completed. At any given time no more than ten (10) permits will be issued.
- b. Upon the County's granting of a permit to operate a car rental service at the Airport, holders of valid and current rental car operator ground transportation permits shall pay the following annual permit fee to the County for the use of the facilities for car rental services:

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*10% of the permit holder's gross revenues for each calendar year the permit is active.

"Gross revenues" shall mean all amounts paid or payable to the car rental company arising out of its operations conducted at, to or from the Airport, including:

1. The use, rental or lease of vehicles;
2. Parking or storage of vehicles;
3. The use of a shuttle vehicle transporting customers to or from the Airport; and
4. Recovery from customers of the annual permit fee described herein.

"Gross revenues" shall not include gasoline charges for vehicles rented, nor amounts collected from customers for federal, state, county or municipal taxes.

- c. Administration of the above fee schedule shall be pursuant to directive issued by the County's Department of Transportation & Infrastructure.
2. The Code's index shall be amended and renumbered to reflect these Amendments to the Code.
3. All remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 2003-8, adopted April 24, 2003, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
4. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to comply with the publication of the Ordinance with the provisions of law.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
6. The Clerk to the Board shall forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Office of the County Executive, County Counsel, Deputy County Administrator of the Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, and Airport Manager.
