**ORDINANCE NO.** 2015-5

- 2 -

1. The speed limits for both directions of traffic along (County Route 579), Bear Tavern Road, Township of Ewing, County of Mercer, be amended as follows:  
  
35 M.P.H. 700' south of Windy Bush Drive to 1000' north of Maddock Road; and,
2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of Chosen Freeholders; and,
3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; now, therefore,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board shall forward three (3) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for submission and distribution to the Municipal Clerk of the Township of Ewing, upon approval, and a copy to the Office of the Deputy Administrator/Director of the Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.
