THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish a Midblock Crosswalk on certain areas that are open to the public or to which the public is invited as set forth below.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, which does confer upon Mercer County the right to establish certain regulations in the interest of public safety and the expedition of traffic on roadways under Mercer County jurisdiction.
- 3. The location herein is designated as a Midblock Crosswalk:
