WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. The speed limit for both directions of traffic along Rosedale Road (County Route 604), Municipality of Princeton, be amended as follows:

Zone 1: 35 MPH from the east curb line of Elm Road (County Route 604) to Province Line Road, the municipal boundary between Lawrence Township and Princeton, except for 25 MPH when passing through the Johnson Park School Zone, while "25 MPH When Flashing" signs are operating during recess or while children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing hours; thence,

- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and,
- 3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners forward four (4) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for submission to the Princeton Municipal Clerk and distribution upon approval and one (1) certified copy to the Director, Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.
