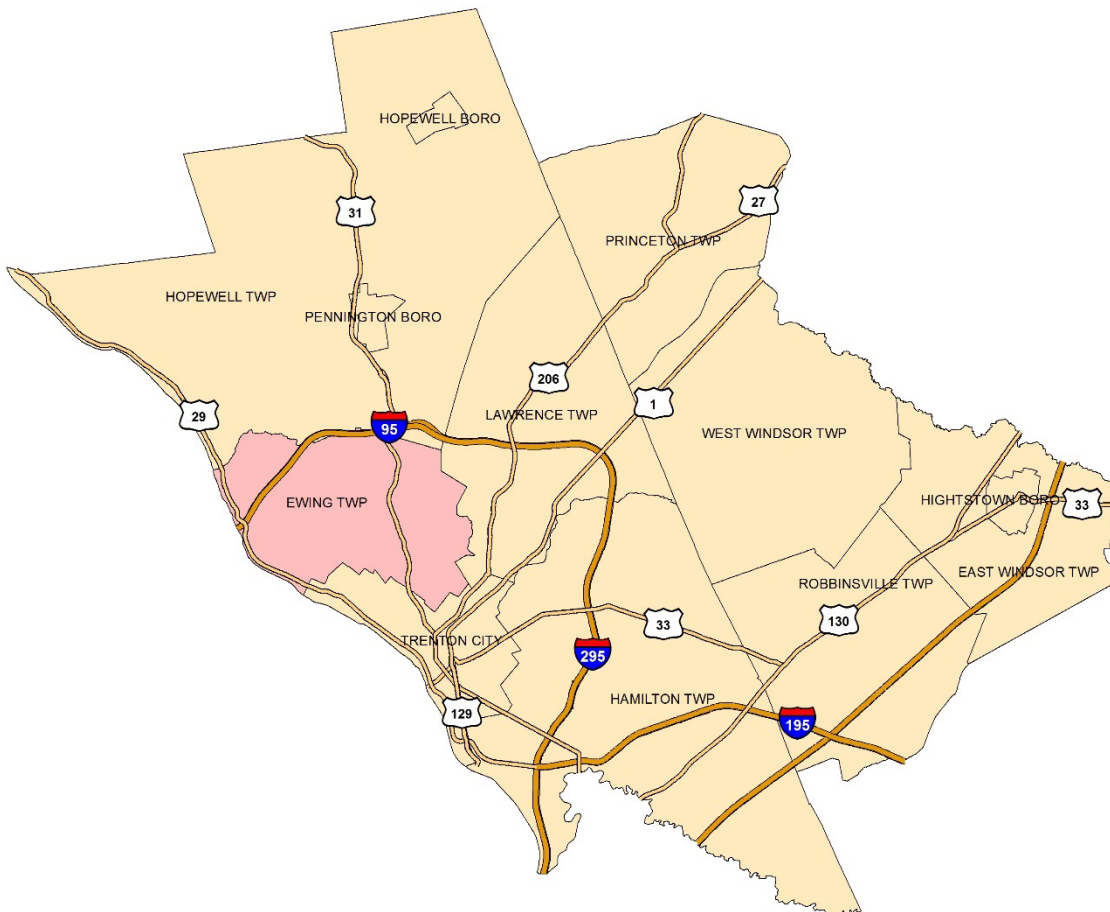


## EWING TOWNSHIP AT A GLANCE

### GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY

Ewing Township is 15.1 square miles and is partly bordered by the Delaware River. Largely settled by Scots and British from Long Island in 1700, Ewing Township was severed from the City of Trenton in 1834, taking its name from Chief Justice Charles Ewing. Many important state and county facilities are located in Ewing Township, including The College of New Jersey and Trenton–Mercer Airport.
