GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY

Hightstown Borough is 1.2 square miles and is entirely surrounded by East Windsor Township. One of the earliest settled communities in New Jersey, Hightstown derived its name from the Haight family, but was confused as "Hidestown," "Icetown," or "Night Town" during the Revolutionary War. Hightstown was incorporated in 1853.
