Hopewell Borough is 0.8 square miles surrounded by Hopewell Township. The village of Hopewell was the birthplace of John Hart, one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. Hopewell Borough became incorporated in 1891 and retains its Colonial village character within its Victorian-era neighborhoods at the foot of the Sourland Mountains.
