MERCER COUNTY AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT BOARD RESOLUTION DENYING APPLICATION OF 83 CHURCH ST. LLC FOR SPECIAL OCCASION EVENTS

83 CHURCH ST. LLC 83 Church Street Block 14, Lots 13, 45 and 46 Robbinsville Township, Mercer County

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Special Occasion Events Act, N.J.S.A. 4:1C-32.15 et seq. (the "SOE Law"), a commercial farm owner or operator may make application to the holder of a development easement, whether a County Agriculture Development Board, a non-profit entity or the State of New Jersey, for permission to hold Special Occasion Events ("SOEs") on preserved farms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the SOE Law, a Special Occasion Event is defined as a wedding, a lifetime milestone event or other cultural or social event conducted, in whole or in part, on preserved farmland on a commercial farm; and

WHEREAS, one of the primary purposes of the SOE Law is to assist with agri-tourism and attract the public to working farms for enjoyment and educational purposes and provide farm owners with additional income and increased marketing of the farm's products; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the SOE Law, SOEs may be held on preserved farms so long as certain criteria are met, including but not limited to, the following:

- 1. The preserved farm must be a commercial farm as determined under N.J.S.A.
- 2. The SOE is to be held on the preserved farm.
- 3. The SOE cannot interfere with the use of the preserved farm for agricultural or horticultural production.
- 4. The SOE is to have minimal effects on the "occupied area" of the preserved farm.
- 5. Up to 26 SOEs are permitted at preserved farms per calendar year.
- 6. Of the maximum 26 SOEs, no more than 6 may have attendees in excess of 250 persons
- 7. The occupied area for the SOE cannot exceed the lesser of (i) 10 acres or (ii) 10% of the preserved farm.
- 8. A single SOE can last 2 consecutive days if marketed as a single event. If a SOE lasts more than 2 consecutive days it is considered to be multiple SOEs.
- A SOE must use existing parking on the preserved farm. Additional on-site
 areas for temporary parking is permitted if the standards for on-farm direct
 marketing facilities, activities and event under the Right to Farm Statutes are
 complied with.
- 10. If the SOE will involve traffic and/or public safety issues, the input of the municipality may be sought and considered.

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2023, 83 Church St. LLC, owner of the preserved farm located at 83 Church Street, Robbinsville, New Jersey (Block 14, Lots 13, 45 and 46) made application to the

Mercer County Agriculture Development Board for permission to hold periodic special occasion events over the course of approximately three (3) months, commencing in August 2023 through October 2023. A copy of the application is attached hereto as Exhlbit A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the application, the purpose of the SOE was to hold cultural events for the community and outside visitors associated with the grand opening of the temple being constructed on adjacent property and for use of the farmland as "temporary use of parking" associated with such grand opening; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the application, 83 Church St. LLC represented that 40 acres of the 66 +/- acre preserved farm would be used for overflow parking purposes, with the SOE being held on an adjacent parcel owned by 83 Church St. LLC; and

WHEREAS, the dates of the events for the SOEs was listed as being held over eleven (11) three day periods, commencing August 3, 2023 and ending October 15, 2023; and

WHEREAS, 83 Church St. LLC represented in the application that approximately twenty of these SOEs would have more than 250 persons present; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the SOE Law, the easement holder (in this case, the County of Mercer) has a period of 90 days from receipt of a SOE application to make a determination of approval or disapproval; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2023, 83 Church St. LLC requested expedited review of the application so as to accelerate the commencement of the SOEs and use of the farm for parking to July 15, 2023; and

WHEREAS, 83 CHURCH ST. LLC was advised by the County Planning Director, Leslie Floyd, on July 11, 2023 that the SOE application would be heard at the Mercer County Agriculture Development Board's August 7, 2023 meeting and that no parking on the preserved farm was permitted in the interim.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, after having reviewed the SOE application submitted by 83 Church St. LLC on June 30, 2023 and the pertinent provisions of the SOE Law, the Mercer County Agricultural Development Board, at its August 7, 2023 meeting, hereby determines as follows:

The application submitted by 83 Church St. LLC for permission to hold special occasion events on the preserved farm located at Block 14, Lots 13, 45 and 46, is denied for the following reasons:

- i. The preserved farm is proposed to be used for parking purposes in support of, associated with, and ancillary to a special occasion event to be held on adjacent property, which is in contravention of the SOF I aw requirement that the special occasion event be held on the preserved farm.
- ii. The number of events exceed those permitted under the SOE Law.
- iii. The number of visitors to the preserved farm exceed those permitted under the SOE Law. $\label{eq:condition} % \begin{subarray}{ll} \end{subarray} % \begin{subarray}{ll} \end{su$

Even if the Special Occasion Events were to be held on the preserved farm, the proposed acreage exceeds that which is permitted under the SOE Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board shall forward a copy of this determination to 83 Church St. LLC, the SADC, Robbinsville Township, and any other individuals or organizations deemed appropriate by the Board.
