### <u>Update: MC One Stop Activities</u> – Virgen Velez

#### Youth Career Awareness Activities

- Career Fair
  - Provide information on training opportunities to target young people who are graduating in June 2023, but are not collegebound; all youth ages 18-24 and adults will be welcome
  - o Construction trades, training providers, NJMEP, MCTS and MCCC will be invited to participate
  - It will tentatively be held at the Cure Arena to be held from 4 p.m. 6 p.m. to encourage parents to attend
  - Marketing will be key to the success of above activities
  - Target date will be last week of May/1st week of June
  - It was suggested having an event that will potentially draw youth i.e. I Drone racing) or similar activity to get youth excited – this will be explored
  - A subcommittee, with members from all committees, will be formed to work on this project
  - Virtual Career Awareness Information Session Information to be held virtually, mimicking the career fair information



The NGO (Notice of Grant Opportunity) for the SYEP was released last Friday. There was a brief discussion as to the possibility of having an in-person "job fair" as a means of matching youth to a worksite in lieu of the Youth Team making the matches.

The consensus was that it was a good idea to restart the "placement fair" for this year's program. All youth selected for participation in the program would be guaranteed a job but may not necessarily be at their first choice.

### **Update: MCCC**

- \*Laura Sosa sent the update below
  - Spring semester will begin on January 20<sup>th</sup>
  - Michael Hanna's partnership working with the local robotics has resulted in a lot of interest from Ewing High School whose students are registering for classes at MCCC for credits
  - Michael is still teaching interested students from TCHS; one student will be taking evening class at MCCC
  - MCCC is moving ahead with a partnership with NJMEP (more information at future meeting)

# **Update: NJMEP - Larry Banks**

- New programs are being developed for high school students and any other interested individuals
  - CAD design, 3-D printing and basic skills for tools/mechanics should be available in April
- Invitations for Manufacturing Day will be sent to the committee
- NJMEP is offering OSHA certifications to students; offerings will be expanding based on companies' needs
- Companies will be asked for their onboarding plans to be able to assist students be better prepared for the hiring process
- Training times (day/eve) by NJMEP is flexible; hybrid options also available
