

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. The speed limits for both directions of traffic along Washington Road (County Route 571) BETWEEN U.S. Route 1 and Ivy Lane, West Windsor Township, Municipality of Princeton, Mercer County, are to be established as follows:

Zone 1: 45 MPH between U.S. Route 1 and a point 1,760 feet north of U.S. Route 1; thence

Zone 2: 35 MPH between a point 1,760 feet north of U.S. Route 1 and a point 290 feet south of Ivy Lane.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and,
3. Regulatory and Warning signs shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners shall forward four (4) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for submission to the West Windsor Township and Municipality of Princeton Municipal Clerks and distribution upon approval and one (1) certified copy to the Director, Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.



WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Mercer County is replacing Bridge #250.3 carrying County Route 569 (Carter Road) over Bedens Brook; and,
2. The bridge replacement project is scheduled to take 270 calendar days; and,
3. Traffic will be maintained as alternating single lane traffic through the site using a temporary traffic signal; and,
4. The speed limit for both directions of traffic along Carter Road (County Road 569) is to be temporarily established as follows:

Zone 1: 30 MPH between a point 360 feet south of the centerline of Bedens Brook and the Hopewell Borough Line

5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and,
6. The duration of the temporary speed limit shall be instated from the date of issuance of the Notice to Proceed for the Replacement of Mercer County Bridge #250.3 Carter Road over Bedens Brook and end upon the official determination of substantial completion of the project by the County Engineer; and,
7. Regulatory and Warning signs shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners shall forward four (4) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for submission to the Hopewell Township Clerk and distribution upon approval and one (1) certified copy to the Director, Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-12

WHEREAS, the County of Mercer adopted Ordinance No. 2010-4 dated May 27, 2010 establishing speed limits on Cranbury Road (County Route 615), West Windsor Township; and,

WHEREAS, an Amendment No. 1 to said Ordinance is now required to reduce the speed limits; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. The speed limit for both directions of traffic along Cranbury Road (County Route 615) BETWEEN Princeton-Hightstown Road (County Route 571) and the Mercer-Middlesex County Corporate Line, West Windsor Township, Mercer County, are to be amended as follows:

Zone 1: 25 MPH from Princeton-Hightstown Road to a point 350 feet east of the center of Steele Drive; thence

Zone 2: 30 MPH from a point approximately 350 feet east of the center of Steel Drive to a point 750 feet east of the center of Rabbit Hill Road; thence

Zone 3: 40 MPH from a point 750 feet east of the center of Rabbit Hill Road and the Mercer-Middlesex County Corporate Line.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and,
3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners shall forward four (4) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for submission to the West Windsor Township Municipal Clerk and distribution upon approval and one (1) certified copy to the Director, Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.
