- Route Deviation: Request for a route deviation (no more than .2 miles from the route), must be made by calling (609) 989-6827, Monday – Friday, 8:30-4:00; 24 hours in advance of desired service to be considered. Requests must be received by a representative, voice/e-mail requests will not be accepted.

- Buses are lift equipped.
- Service animals and portable oxygen permitted onboard the bus.
- Timetables are available in alternative formats.
- Open to the public.
