WDB Oversight

- Expenditures Summary Committee reviewed expenditures through 6/30/23 for PY 21 (7/1/21 6/30/23) & PY 22 (7/1/22 6/30/24)
 - o PY 21
 - WFNJ funds subject to recapture from NJDOL include \$1,427,142 TANF & \$550,242 GA/SNAP this was due to the Pandemic during which time because participation was not mandatory we significantly reduced the number of contracts. Approximately \$388,000 in Adult & \$346,00 in DW funds are also subject to recapture for similar reasons.
 - o PY 22
 - NJDOL has extended the expenditure period for WFNJ until 9/30/23 normally 6/30. WIOA Adult, Dislocated Worker, & Youth funds can be spent through 6/30/24
- Performance Measures
 - PY 22 Common Measures
 - 14 Measures 11 Exceeded; 1 Met; 2 Not Met
- PY 23 Budget
 - The NOA (Notice of Awards) have not been received for PY 23 they will need to be approved by the Board of Commissioners for information into the County budget. We will ask for a conditional approval from the Board with the authority given to the Executive Committee to provide final approval.
