- Contracted Services Isles
 - o 13 achieved their HSE
 - Contract was renewed July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024

 - o We exceeded the two Youth Employment Retention measures & the Youth Credential measure
 - o Skill Gains measure was not met; we will explore to identify the cause(s) and implement solutions

PY 2023 Youth Update

- The SYEP ended on September 1st; Data will be reported to the State and shared at the next meeting
- 130 youth began the program and over 100 completed
- SkillUp was used for the job readiness component; this was 2.5 self-driven hours weekly; data on how many youth actually participated will be determined for report

Highlights

- Need to increase YIC membership and meeting attendance
