The ballot design for this Democratic Primary Election has changed to a block style under a federal court order. The Republican ballot style has not changed under the same court's order and candidates are in a line format.

## VOTING MACHINE INSTRUCTIONS

- After signing the E-Poll Book you, the voter, are handed a paper Voting Authority.
- Take this to the ICP - Ballot Marking Device and hand the Voting Authority to the Board Worker.

<p><b>3</b></p>  <p><b>Touch the screen</b> to select your choices. To vote for any person whose name is not printed on this ballot, fill in the oval by the words "Write-In". Insert the name of the person for which you wish to vote on the blank line.</p>	<p><b>7</b></p>  <p><b>At the ICP - Scanner</b>, feed the ballot into the tabulator entry slot.</p>

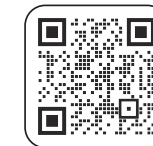

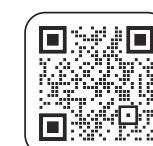
