The ballot design for this Democratic Primary Election has changed to a block style under a federal court order. The Republican ballot style has not changed under the same court's order and candidates are in a line format.

VOTING MACHINE INSTRUCTIONS

- After signing the E-Poll Book you, the voter, are handed a paper Voting Authority.
- **Take this to the ICX - Ballot Marking Device** and hand the Voting Authority to the Board Worker.

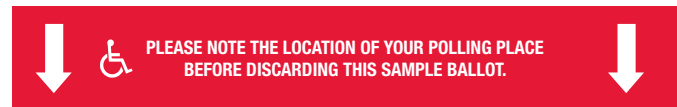

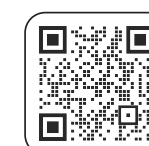
