MERCER COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS URGES THE NEW JERSEY STATE INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION TO RECONSIDER THEIR DENIAL OF THE WEST WINDSOR-PLAINSBORO SCHOOL DISTRICTS PROPOSAL OF COMBINING FOOTBALL PROGRAMS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR

WHEREAS, the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders strongly believes that the goal of interscholastic athletics is for student athletes to learn the value of teamwork, pride, respect, commitment, and sportsmanship on and off the playing field; and,

WHEREAS, in order to prevent West Windsor-Plainsboro North from cancelling its season due to overall low student interest and sign up, the West Windsor-Plainsboro school district sought permission from the New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association (NJSIAA) to merge both the North and South's football team for a period of one-year. Combining both teams would have created a safe and competitive squad of at least 40 players; and,

WHEREAS, the NJSIAA Leagues and Conference voted against the proposal on May 23, 2017 out of concern that combining both football teams, both classified as "Group IV," could create a powerhouse team. West Windsor-Plainsboro sought an appeal from the New Jersey Department of Education, but was ultimately rejected; and,

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WHEREAS, NJSIAA's verdict resulted in West Windsor-Plainsboro North being forced to cancel the 2017 football season; and,

WHEREAS, neighboring West Windsor-Plainsboro South, despite similar low interest and sign up numbers, was just able to reach a reasonable amount of players to field a team for this season; and,

WHEREAS, participation in sports is very important to students who seek to attend institutions of higher education, both as part of the application process and also as financing higher education through scholarships, and depriving students the ability to participate in sports harms students' efforts to further their education; and,

WHEREAS, due to increased concern over concussions and a general decline in sports participation by students, along with the high expense of providing sports programs will undoubtedly lead to more such consolidation requests; and,

WHEREAS, the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders believes that the NJSIAA should amend its rules to allow for a case by case evaluation of such requests, and that as part of its evaluation process, the NJSIAA should recognize that school districts may not be seeking competitive advantage but may, in fact, simply be seeking to continue a program that is experiencing a decline in enrollment and that consolidation may be the best way forward in providing students with athletic and competitive opportunities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders, that:

- 1. In an effort to grant all students with the opportunity to compete in interscholastic athletics, the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders urges New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association to reconsider their denial of the West Windsor-Plainsboro School Districts proposal of combining football programs for a period of one year.
- The Clerk to the Board shall forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the New Jersey Interscholastic Athletic Association and all Legislators that represent Mercer County.

MERCER COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS HEREBY RECOGNIZE AUGUST 7, 2017 AS THE $235^{\rm TH}$ ANNIVERSARY OF THE CREATION OF THE "PURPLE HEART"

WHEREAS, On August 7, 1782, in Newburgh, New York, General George Washington created the "Badge of Military Merit," which was a decoration consisting of a purple, heart-shaped piece of silk, edged in silver biding, with the word Merit stitched across the face in silver; and,

WHEREAS, the "Badge of Military Merit," was presented to soldiers who displayed "meritorious action", and those receiving the badge received permission to pass guards and sentinels without challenge; and,

WHEREAS, General Washington's "Badge of Military Merit," was awarded to only three known soldiers during the Revolutionary War: Elijah Churchill, William Brown, and Daniel Bissell, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, The Book of Merit was lost and the military decoration known as the "Purple Heart was largely forgotten until the year 1927; and,

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WHEREAS, in 1931, General Douglas MacArthur, took up the cause, hoping to reinstate the medal in time for the bicentennial of George Washington's birth. On February 22, 1932, Washington's 200th birthday, the U.S. War Department announced the creation of the "Order of the Purple Heart"; and,

WHEREAS, in addition to aspects of Washington's original design, the new Purple Heart also displays a bust of Washington and his coat of arms; and,

WHEREAS, the Order of the Purple Heart, the oldest American military decoration for military merit, is awarded to members of the U.S. armed forces who have been killed or wounded in action against an enemy; and,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders hereby recognize August 7, 2017 as the 235th Anniversary of the Creation of the "Purple Heart"; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk to the Board shall send a copy of this Resolution to each Freeholder Board throughout the State of New Jersey.
